Purpose/Background

Provision shall be made by the Board to recognize employees who have provided long service and/or employees who are formally retiring.

Procedures

- 1. Long Service Awards
 - 1.1 The Division shall recognize employees who have provided long service in the following manner:
 - 1.1.1 At 10 and 15 years of service employees shall receive a letter of appreciation from the Superintendent.
 - 1.1.2 At 20, 25, 30, 35 and 40 years of service employees will be recognized with a gift of appreciation. These employees will be guests at the annual awards and recognition evening.
 - 1.2 In order to qualify for a long service award, an employee must:
 - 1.2.1 Have served the Division continuously for the required number of years; and
 - 1.2.2 Still be working at the Division or must have retired during the last school year.

2. Formal Retirement

- 2.1 The Division shall honour its employees on their formal retirement provided that:
 - 2.1.1 They are formally retiring and are serving the Division at the time of retirement;
 - 2.1.2 They have served the Division for a minimum of five (5) years; and
 - 2.1.3 They have reached fifty-five (55) years of age by June 30 of the year of their retirement.
- 2.2 Retirement Awards:
 - 2.1.1 Employees shall be recognized appropriately to the number of years of service; and
 - 2.1.2 Retirees will be guests of the Division at the annual awards and recognition evening.
- 3. Once an employee receives a retirement award they will not be eligible for any other long-service or retirement awards.
