Mahan holds a Bachelor of Physical Education and a Bachelor of Education After Degree, both from the University of Calgary. He also has participated in, and organized, numerous professional development opportunities within the jurisdiction, Alberta Education, the Calgary Education Foundational Partnership and the Centre for Leadership and Learning.
