Rocky View Schools' (RVS) Superintendent of Schools Greg Luterbach is pleased to announce the following leadership appointments, effective August 2018.



Jordan Fenton, Principal, East Lake School

The Principal of Chestermere High School since 2013, Jordan Fenton will move to the role of Principal of East Lake School in Chestermere. Fenton arrived in Rocky View in 2008 from Buffalo Trails Public Schools where he served as Principal of Manville School, a K-12 school with 240 students and 25 staff members. During his tenure with Rocky View, Jordan also served as the Assistant Principal of Chestermere High School.

Fenton holds a Master of Education from the University of Portland and two bachelor's degrees, one in Education from the University of Alberta, the other in Arts from Augustana University College in Camrose.



Sandy McDuffe, Principal, W.H. Croxford High School

Having served as the Principal of Meadowbrook School since 2016, Sandy McDuffe will move into the role of Principal of W.H. Croxford High School in Airdrie. McDuffe arrived in RVS from Livingstone Range School Division where she served as Principal of Matthew Halton High School, helping to engage students in learning through their own individual pathways. Previous to that role, she served as a teacher, vice principal, and principal in Tumbler Ridge, BC, part of the School District No 59.

McDuffe holds a Master of Educational Leadership from the University of Lethbridge and a Bachelor of Education from Brandon University.



Ryan Siemens, Principal, Sarah Thompson School

After a 16-year tenure with Prairie Waters Elementary School, Ryan Siemens will take the helm of Sarah Thompson School in Langdon. Siemens' history with Rocky View School dates back to 1998, when he joined the jurisdiction as a Grade 4 and 5 teacher at the former Conrich School. In 2002, Siemens transferred to Prairie Waters to teach, moving into the Assistant Principal position in late 2004 and the Principal role in 2011.

Siemens graduated with a Bachelor of Arts from the University of Calgary in 1996. He moved on to earn a Bachelor of Education in 1998 and a Master of Education in Leadership and School Improvement in 2007, both from the University of Alberta.

Holding the title of Principal of Sarah Thompson School since it opened in 2012, Michelle Doz will move into the role of Principal of Prairie Waters Elementary School in Chestermere. First joining Chinook’s Edge as a teacher in 1991, Doz served the board until 2009, when she moved into the role of Assistant Principal position at RVS’ Langdon School.

Doz holds a Master of Business Administration from the University of Calgary and a Bachelor of Education from the University of Alberta.

Competitions for the principalships of R.J. Hawkey Elementary School, Chestermere High School, Meadowbrook Middle School and the new Hillcrest School will be held shortly.
