Rocky View Schools' (RVSD) Superintendent of Schools Greg Bass is pleased to announce the appointment of Heather Hill as Acting Principal of Ecole Edwards Elementary in Airdrie, effective **February 1, 2009**.



“Heather has a wealth of experience in the education field, specifically at the elementary level and with both French Immersion and special needs services,” said Bass. “I congratulate her on this new appointment and express my thanks to her for stepping up to the Acting Principalship until June 2009.”

Hill takes over the principalship of Ecole Edwards Elementary from Brenda Herring, who is retiring at the end of January 2009. Currently the Assistant Principal of Edwards, Hill has worked in Rocky View since 1998, first as a resource and literacy teacher at Glenbow, then as a resource teacher at Ecole Edwards School. Hill moved into the role of assistant principal at Edwards in 2007. Prior to her arrival in Rocky View, Hill worked for several schools in Manitoba as a classroom, resource and special education teacher.

Hill holds a Masters in Education, specializing in educational research/educational leadership from the University of Calgary and a Bachelor of Education from Brandon University in Manitoba. A life-long learner, Hill also has completed a number of educational and leadership development courses, including non-violent Crisis Intervention, Risk and Threat Assessment, Seven Habits of Highly Effective People and Rocky View Administrative Leadership Program.
