



SchoolEngage – What is it?

SchoolEngage is an online platform which allows Parents/Guardians to:

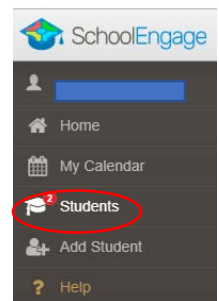
- Register a student that is brand new to Rocky View Schools
- Register new members of the family
- Register student(s) for Transportation (busing)
- Update/confirm their annual Demographic/School Confirmation information online

Did you know:

- Rocky View Schools provides transportation for the Catholic School Division
- Catholic Parents can also register for transportation through SchoolEngage
- Catholic Parents Do Not fill out the School Registration form

New Parents/Guardians (never had a student enrolled in a Rocky View School before)

- Create a SchoolEngage account at <https://rockyview.schoolengage.ca>
- Wait for email notification to complete account creation
- Click on “Add Student” and complete the information, Submit
- Now click on “Students” and select the student you just created.
- You will now see the 2018-2019 Student Registration form and the 2018-2019 Transportation Registration form
- Complete the online registration form with supporting documents and Submit
- Parents/Guardians can register and pay for transportation after the school registration form is submitted
- Schools will process registration and Parents/Guardians will receive an email notification of approval
- Once approved the school will provide Parents/Guardians with PowerSchool access codes by printing off the Web ID and Password Letter from PowerSchool



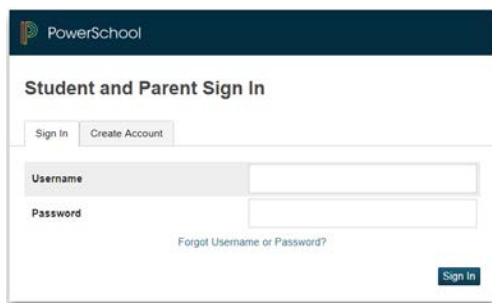
Approved - New Parents/Guardians will now access SchoolEngage through the PowerSchool Parent Portal

PowerSchool Parent Portal: gives parents and students access to real-time information including attendance, grades and detailed assignment descriptions, school bulletins, lunch menus and even personal messages from the teacher. Everyone stays connected: Students stay on top of assignments, parents/guardians can participate more fully in their student’s progress, and teachers can use their Gradebook to make decisions on what information they want to share with parents and students.
