Purpose/Background

Rocky View Schools has a number of educators delivering innovative teaching practices, and students undertaking projects that make a difference in their school and/or community. In order to recognize the hard work of these outstanding individuals, the Board of Trustees of Rocky View Schools will allot time during two meetings per month for individuals or groups to come forth and share more about what they are doing.

Procedures

Board Showcase (Exemplary Practice and Student Showcase)

- Rocky View's Communications Department will extend invitations to educators who have created unique programs and teaching practices or students in the Division who have formed groups or developed projects that have had a positive effect in their classroom, school, and/or community. The Board Showcase will take place during the Board Meeting on the 1st and 3rd Thursdays of each month, will commence at 10 a.m., and is to run a maximum of 20 minutes, including Q & A.
- 2. The Communications Department will distribute a questionnaire to the educator(s) or teacher advisor of the student(s) being asked to showcase their material or project to the Board. This form is then to be returned to the Communications Department a week prior to the board meeting. The information will be used to develop a memo that will be distributed to the Board the morning of the said showcase.
- 3. If a substitute teacher is required to fill-in for a staff member on the day of the showcase, the Board will cover the cost of a half-day substitute. The teacher shall enter an absence in Atrieve using the absence code "Meetings", then selecting the "Board Meetings" option on the last screen.
