Rocky View Schools' (RVS) Superintendent of Schools Greg Luterbach is pleased to announce the appointment of Lori Meyer, Ed.D. as Associate Superintendent of Learning, effective Feb. 1, 2021.

“An accomplished 25-year career as a teacher, student support teacher, vice principal, principal, registered psychologist and most recently superintendent, Lori brings a wealth of experience and knowledge in public education to RVS,” said Luterbach. “I extend my congratulations to Lori and look forward to welcoming her to our team early next year.”

Lori joins RVS from Prairie South Schools in Moose Jaw, Saskatchewan, where she has held the role of Superintendent of Learning since 2011. Prior to that, Lori served the division as Superintendent of Student Support

Services and Student Support Consultant and Psychologist. Lori also taught for several years in rural Saskatchewan.

Throughout her time with Prairie South Schools Lori has successfully planned, implemented, revised, and monitored various teaching and inclusive learning programs achieving significant results. Through Lori's leadership, student reading scores increased by nearly 10 per cent due to the improved reading plan her team implemented across the division. Lori was also responsible for leading an initiative that successfully secured provincial and local board funded prekindergarten programs providing every child in the division with access to a prekindergarten program staffed by a teacher and an assistant.

Community work has been a vital part of her role, partnering with agencies to create and support programs that meet the non-academic needs of children and their families. As a member of the Community Based Coalition, Lori represents the division and works with partners including Mental Health and Addictions, Public Health, Waka First Nations Committee, Moose Jaw Police Services, RCMP and others to build a strong community.

Lori has a Doctor of Education, specialization in Reading and Literacy from Capella University and is a Registered Psychologist from Saskatchewan College of Psychologists.

“On behalf of the Board of Trustees, we look forward to RVS benefiting from Lori's diverse background and experience in public education when she joins the jurisdiction next year,” said Board Chair Fiona Gilbert. “We welcome her and extend our congratulations on her appointment as our new Associate Superintendent of Learning.”
