# **Project Description**

During the 2021/22 school year, Elbow Valley Elementary School used Learning Disruption Funds to curate and introduce a variety of numeracy games to its Grade1-3 classes. This idea was generated through discussions between the school's Numeracy Committee and RVS learning specialists. Each week, a new game was rolled out to students, and an improvement in student learning was observed.

Building on that success, the school has inserted a block into the timetable this year for numeracy games every day for all grades. Learning support and administration teams join classes during this block to help model, teach and improve students' number sense. Many teachers have adopted Peter Liljedahl's concept of creating visibly random groups to remove social barriers, increase student engagement and build collaboration skills for students.

The school has found this is a creative, sustainable and effective way to maximize instructional time and gains in learning. The numeracy games ensure students are actively practicing skills like subitizing, ordering numbers and being flexible with numbers. Parents have expressed appreciation for the engaging ways they can address math practice with their children using items as simple as dice and cards.

# Background;

Annually, Rocky View Schools reviews September 30<sup>th</sup> enrolments.

# **Current Status:**

- Total RVS enrolments for September 30, 2022 have increased by 990 students (+3.72%) to a total of 27,612 students.
- In February 2022, the projected September enrolment sent to Alberta Education was 27,563 students; there were no big swings or large changes at any specific grade level. The most notable differences from projection are the kindergarten numbers (-142) and the online schools (-238).
- Please see attachments for school-by-school enrolments and utilization rates, five-year historical trends by grade, and enrolments by area.

### Background:

This information item is to provide notification, in accordance with Administrative Procedure AP5201, to the Board of Trustees that purchase orders have been issued for the purchase of various items over the amount of \$200,000. Any order over the \$200,000 limit is to be reported to the Board of Trustees.

# **Current Status:**

From June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022 to August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2022 the following purchase orders were issued for an amount over \$200,000.

1. Purchase Order 102570 Issued to Lear Construction Management Ltd.

PO 102570, issued in the amount of \$1,549,196.80. This Purchase Order relates to the George McDougall High School CTS Modernization. IMR Funds.

2. Purchase Order 102668 Issued to Freeze Maxwell Roofing (Calgary) Ltd.

PO 102668, issued in the amount of \$558,571.24. This Purchase Order relates to the partial re-roofing at Chestermere High School. Maintenance Operational Funds.

### 3. Purchase Order 102850 Issued to Insight Canada Inc.

PO 102850, issued in the amount of \$366,481.51. This Purchase Order relates to the purchase of Unified Computer System (servers), to replace aging equipment. Technology Infrastructure Funds.

### 4. Purchase Order 102949 Issued to Wilco Contractors Southwest

Purchase Order 102949, issued in the amount of \$2,595,742.42. This Purchase Order relates to the construction of an artificial turf field at Cochrane High School. Maintenance Sport Field Funds. (Donations and Fund Raising)
