# EXEMPLARY PRACTICE: YELL ENTREPRENEURSHIP AT BERT CHURCH HIGH SCHOOL

#### **Project Description**

In partnership with YELL Canada, Ian Ferguson has been offering an entrepreneurship course at Bert Church High School (BCHS). This course, now in its second year, equips students with an entrepreneurial toolbox and growth mindset to help them become creative problem solvers. In addition to lessons by Ferguson, students learn by listening to guest speakers including members of the Sisters of Airdrie, Grant MacEwan University's Entrepreneur in Residence, the CEO of FCA Strategy and the co-founders of a Code Ninja location. Students also take part in workshop activities. They also work with mentors to refine and improve their business ideas and pitches. BCHS is currently working with Cochrane High School to expand the course.

This type of hands-on learning is one of the outcomes of RVS' Four-Year Education Plan.
