Grade 6 students at Windsong Heights School recently took part in a simulation of the Legislative Assembly for their social studies class where they created and passed a bill. Students were assigned a number of roles including Premier, Opposition Leader, Speaker of the House, Clerk, Page and members of the government and opposition. Each student contributed to the stages of the legislative process. During this presentation, students will explain the process, beginning with the presentation of a proposed bill, through discussions, amendments and debate, and finishing with voting on the bill's passage.

CHAIR REPORT/CORRESPONDENCE

On Feb 15, Chair Gilbert represented RVS at the Government of Alberta's announcement of school construction accelerator program projects. Two RVS projects were advanced from the design phase to the full construction stage – Airdrie SW high school and Chestermere K-9 school in Dawson's Landing. We are grateful for the governments support in moving these projects forward as they are critical for two of our fastest-growing communities. Once built, they will relieve space pressures in some of our most over-utilized schools.

On Feb. 27, the Government of Alberta tabled Budget 2025 in the legislature. The Board has been advocating strongly for changes to the Weighted Moving Average funding model since its inception. The adjustment announced in Budget 2025 is a step in the right direction but does not go far enough to ensure growing school divisions like RVS are not disadvantaged by increasing enrolment. The Board will continue to advocate to the Minister of Education for a funding model for education that is rooted in the principle of every student being fully funded every year.

The Board along with other dignitaries, RVS divisional staff, the community of Langdon and students and staff of Horseshoe Crossing High School will celebrate the official grand opening of RVS' newest school on Mar. 7. It will be great to experience the school's unique culture and school spirit and see this brand-new learning facility that will provide state of the art learning spaces for students and offer a community hub for years to come.
